Most eco-wall papers and coverings' life span are between five and six years, after which it degrades completely.

The Ecowall Fresh is a type two, non-woven wall covering made of 35 per cent pulp, 21 per cent polyester fibre, 14 per cent acrylic, 16.5 per cent adhesive and 13.5 per cent polyester cotton backing. It offers excellent acoustical elements, moisture resistant and is non-allergenic, among others.
